- Boats
 - Currently 8 boats
 - 1 – 2000 hp
 - 3 – 1200 - 1320 hp (1 retractable wheelhouse)
 - 4 – 1000 hp
 - All boats
 - SIRE inspected
 - Meet Sub-chapter M requirements
 - All boats have COI
 - AWO – RCP approved, member of AWO
 - TMSA – Level 1
 - TSMS system
 - AWO Security Plan
 - Crews long-term service with MFS
 - 50%+ wheelmen trained in house on MFS vessels.

MARINE FUELING SERVICE, INC.

- Two marine assets use in fueling operations
 - New barge Texas Fueler
- Provide ULSD with TXLED and dyed for marine use.
- Services
 - Chevron bulk lube buyback program
 - Inland dock side fueling
 - Inland midstream or at another facility
 - ATB and ship midstream for diesel and potentially MDA
 - Lube sales and customer inventory handling
 - DEF
 - Potable water
 - Supplies typical for fuel midstream
 - Slops – bilge and used oil
 - Oil filters
 - Trash household and non-household

TEXAS FUELER



- 4,500 - barrel fuel barge
- 5,300 - gallon Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF) Tank
- 6 – 2,200 – gallon bulk lube oil tanks for buyback programs
- 28,000 - gallons of potable (fresh) water
- 6,500 - gallons of bilge and wastewater storage
- Drum storage for lube or hydraulic oil
- Storage for supplies (hydraulic oil, rags, etc.)
- Trash receptacle for household trash
- Fuel – 3” and 1” hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump
- Lube oil – dedicated hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump for each tank
- DEF – dedicated hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump
- Water - dedicated hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump
- Drums - dedicated hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump to pump directly vessel
- Bilge / Wastewater - dedicated hose on a hose reel and dedicated pump to pull bilges
- The barge is designed with control stations on the Port and Starboard of the barge to control each pump (on, off, variable speed). This ensures the barge tankerman is able to observe the fueling during the entire operation.
- Bergan radar gauges installed on fuel tanks to monitor fuel levels with calibrated gauging's to calculate fuel on board. The units can wirelessly transmit this information to the office.
- Bergan paddle gauges on lube oil and DEF tanks to visually show the level with no cargo risk for a broken site class or other potential leaks the gauges have no cargo exposure.
